TASTING NOTES

Colour: Deep ruby red.

Aroma: Aromas of ripe raspberries and violets, herbal notes and an interesting graphite hint on the nose.

Taste: Refined and vertical on the palate, showing freshness and length. Good concentration of flavours, subtle fine oak influence and gentle, sweet tannins.

Food: Complements red meats, lamb, pork and mature cheeses.

2021 ~ 93 Points. "A spicy and pretty full-bodied red with black beans, dark spices and hints of chocolate, currant leaf and dark olives. A fine twist of tamarind, too. Tannins are very firm and integrated here, delivering a tight but creamy mouthfeel. Pretty long and juicy. 85% cabernet sauvignon and 15% cabernet franc. A big improvement from the past. Drinkable now, but better from 2025." - James Suckling, Feb/2023
