Colour: Deep ruby red.

Aroma: Aromas of ripe raspberries and violets, herbal notes and an interesting

graphite hint on the nose.

Taste: Refined and vertical on the palate, showing freshness and length, Good

concentration of flavours, subtle fine oak influence and gentle, sweet

tannins.

**Food:** Complements red meats, lamb, pork and mature cheeses.

T.H. stands for Terroir Hunter. Grapes were sourced from a selected vineyard in Pirque in the Alto Maipo area. This is located at the foot of the andes Mountain range on the Eastern edge of the Maipo Valley, which is world famous for its perfect climate for red wines.
